How to get to Mile High Campground

We suggest you NOT rely on your GPS system.

- The address is: 4387 Wrights Creek Road, Cherokee, NC 28719 but validate your directions with the instructions below!
- Take Interstate 40 West from Ashville NC.
- Get off at exit 27 (Clyde Waynesville) onto 74
- Take US 74 south for 3.7 miles
- At mile marker 103, turn right (West) on US 19 (Dellwood Road)
- Take US 19 15.2 miles West , through Maggie Valley to the FIRST Blue Ridge Parkway exit at Soco Gap
- Turn left onto the Blue Ridge Parkway (toward Cherokee)
- Take the parkway toward Cherokee for 2.4 miles.
- At Wolf Laurel Gap turn right onto Heintooga Rd. (the sign says Masonic Monument Balsam Mt.)
- The sign (see pic) for the campground will be on the left in less than a mile.
- If you get lost call Big Jon at 803-421-9479

What to Bring:

- Warm clothes (we will be on top of a mountain, it can get into the 30's at night.)
- Personal care items
- Tent, camp chairs
- Sleeping bag and pillow
- Ear plugs (in case of elk snoring)
- Flashlight
- Program literature (Big Book and White Book)
